Flights 'resuming gradually' across the country following FAA system outage

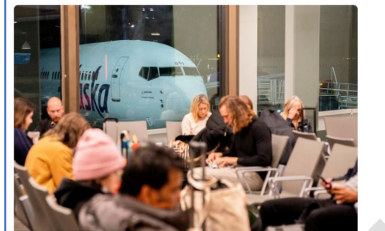

The FAA said air traffic operations are gradually resuming after flights were grounded this morning due to an outage with an important Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) system for pilots.

Earlier this morning the FAA said it was grounding all flights until 9 a.m. ET this morning in order to "validate the integrity of flight and safety information," stemming from an outage with its Notice to Air Missions (NOTAM) system.

Per an update from the FAA, the ground stop has been lifted and 'air traffic operations are resuming gradually across the United States.' The FAA continues to look into the cause of the problem, the agency said.

The NOTAM system sends out flight hazards and restrictions to pilots prior to takeoff. A NOTAM bulletin can sometimes be as long as a couple hundred pages detailing issues like possible bird activity or closed runways.

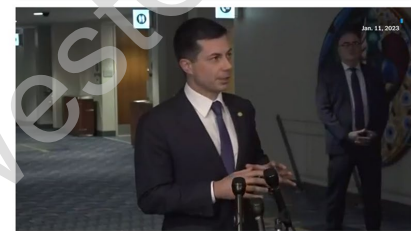

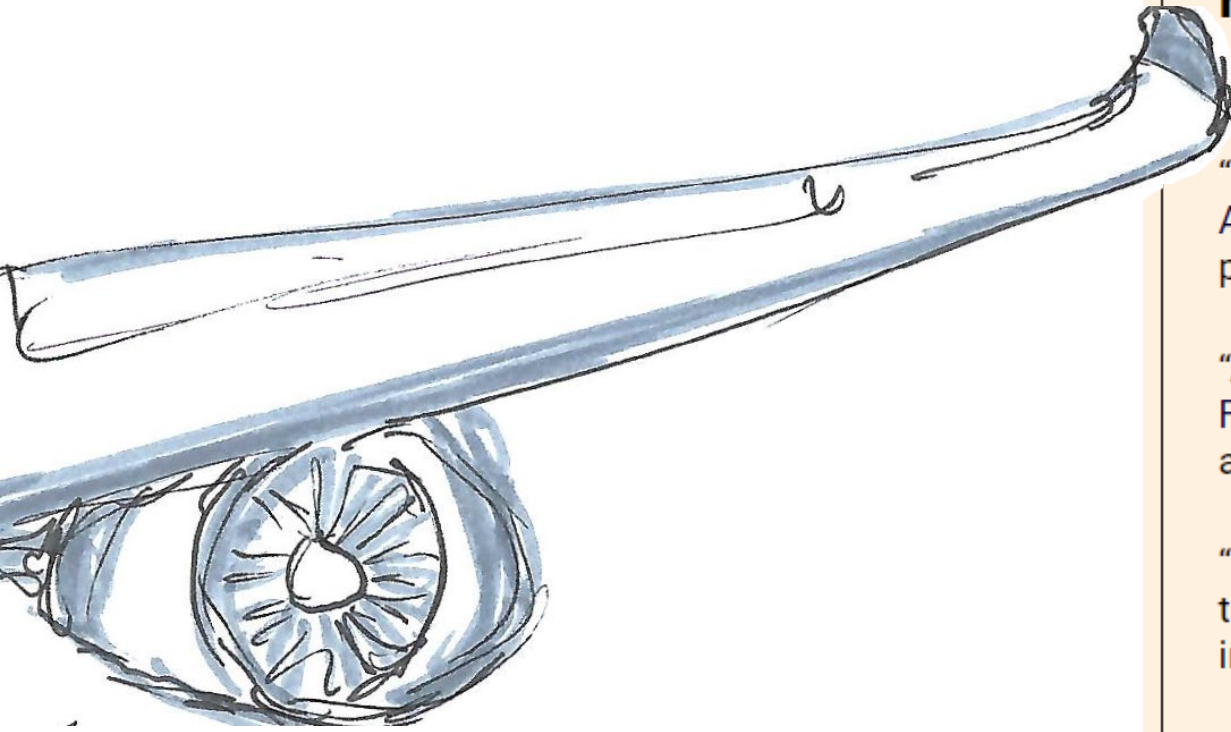

In The Upside Down, The FAA Has Relaxed The Standard For Ensuring Pilots Hearts Don't Stop In Flight

“Concerns and controversy are swirling around the decision by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to alter an electrocardiogram test limit for pilots.

“A researcher for an aviation advocacy group, US Freedom Flyers (USFF), stumbled upon the EKG change in December, several weeks after the FAA enacted it.

“Because the revision was made without a published explanation, USFF turned to a nationally known cardiologist and other experts to assess its importance.

“They say the FAA's change involving “the PR interval” is significant. The PR interval represents the time it takes for an electrical impulse to travel from one part of the heart to another. It is an indicator of heart health.

“But “the new normal” PR interval that the FAA set for pilots is 50 percent longer than the previous limit; it deviates from a long-accepted limit in cardiology.

“Critics fear that expanding the limit could endanger pilots' health and passengers' safety.

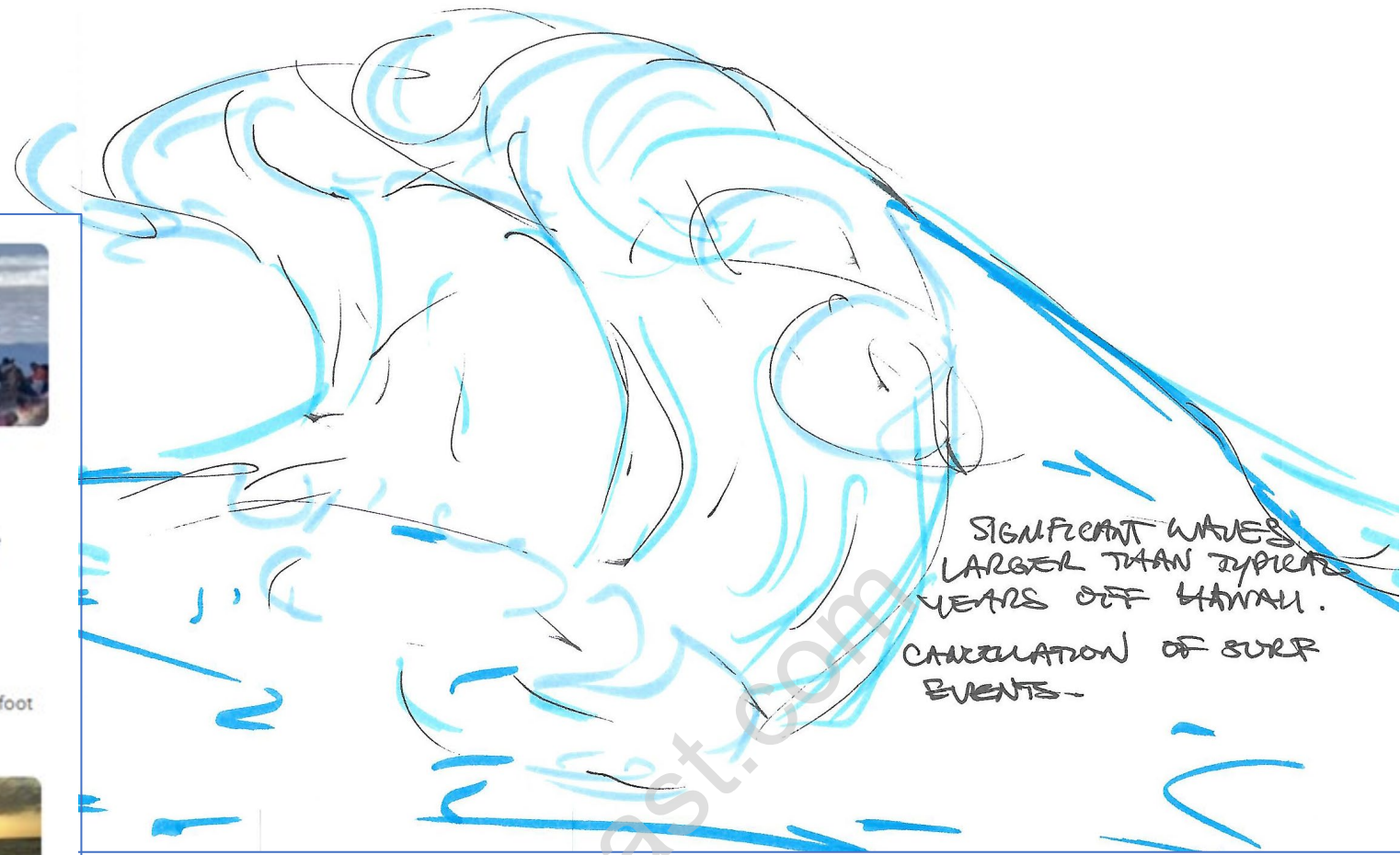

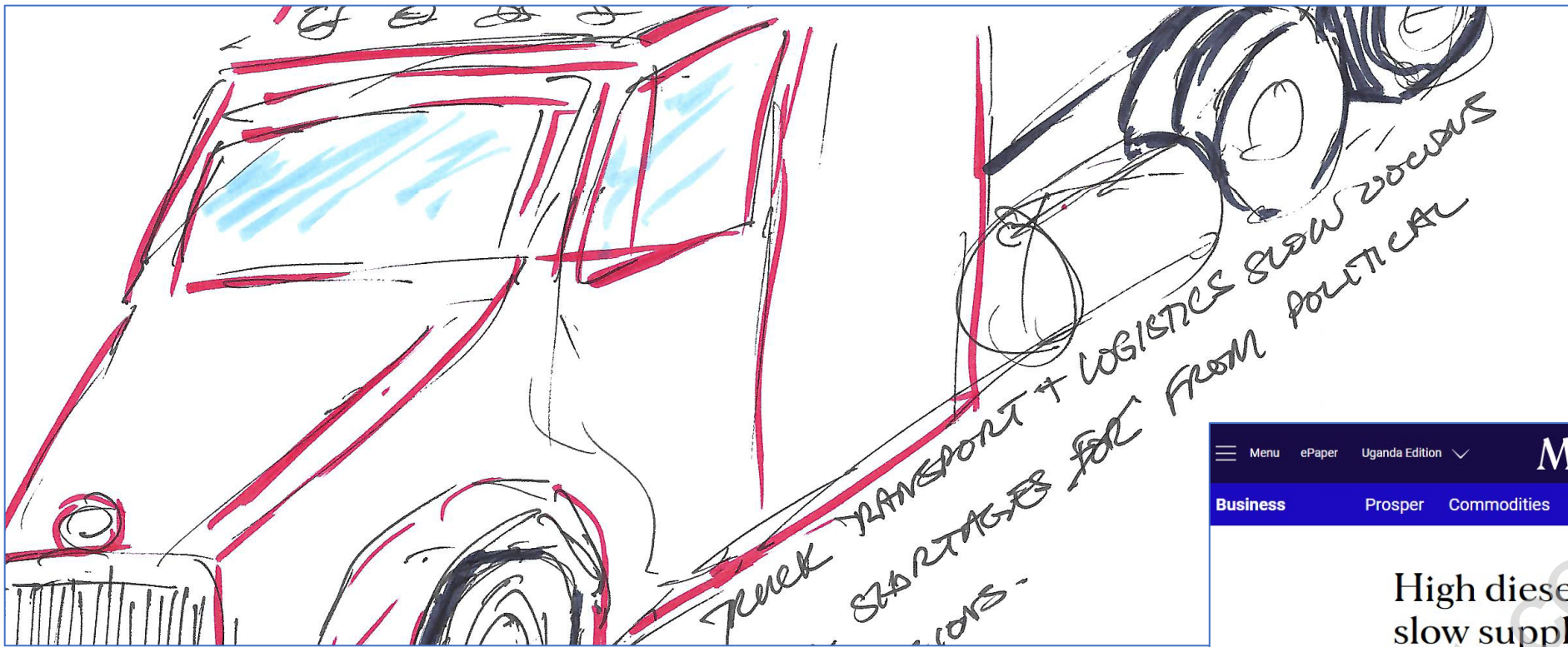



Vincent Ledvina traveled halfway across the world from Alaska to Iceland and spotted surges of green auroras the night of Jan. 13, right over his cabin, cataloging a terabyte's worth of "absolutely bonkers" northern lights footage about two hours from Reykjavík.

"This particular [...] location was legendary and led to some of my favorite aurora compositions ever," said Ledvina in a tweet; he is no stranger to the shimmering green lights given that he is usually based in Fairbanks, Alaska.

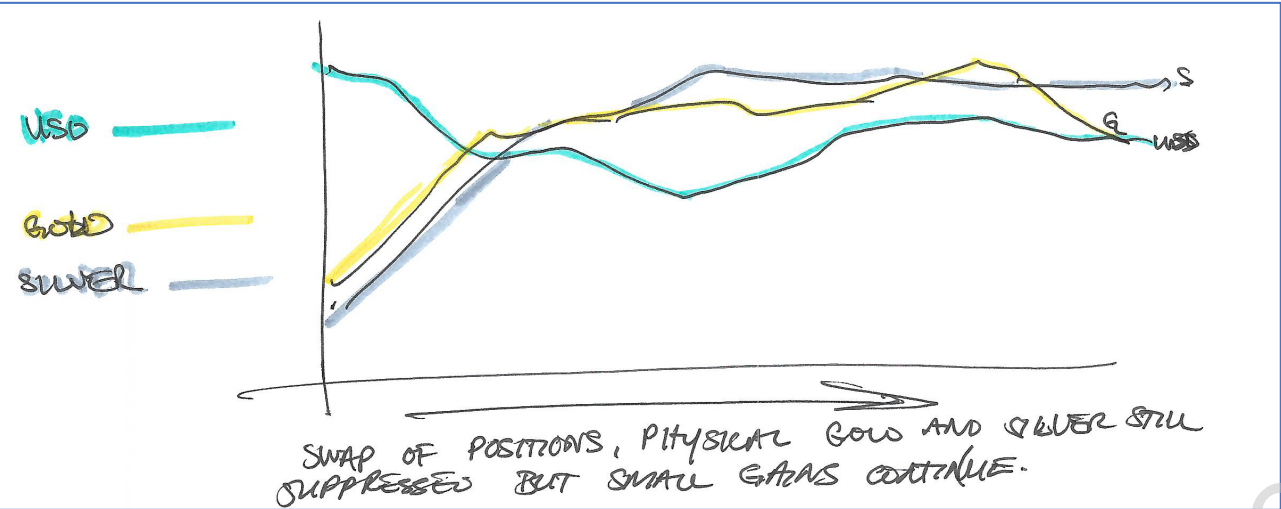
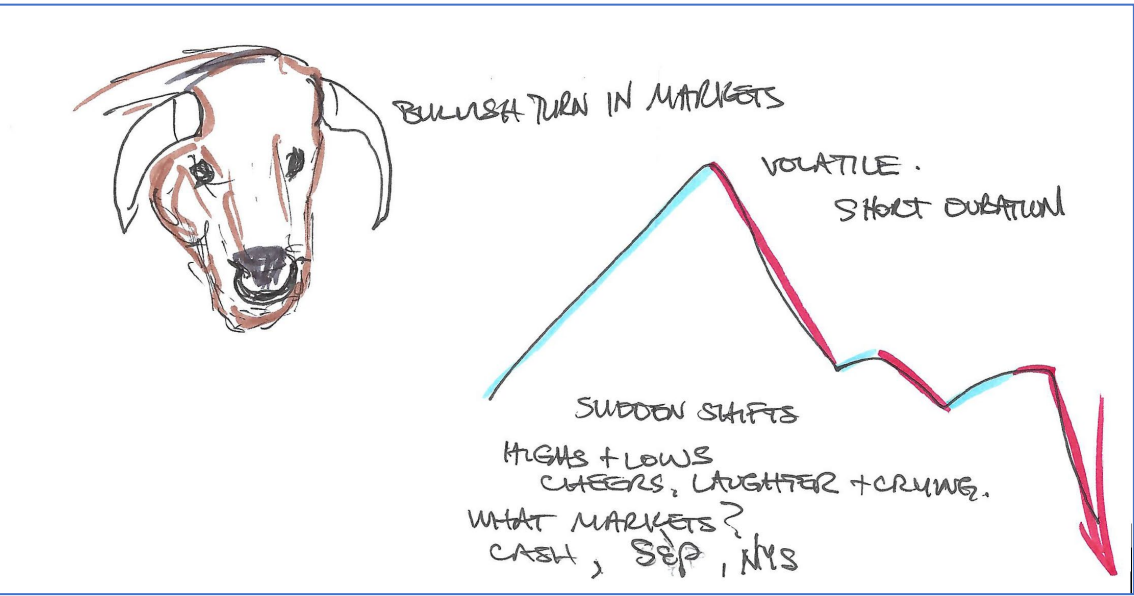

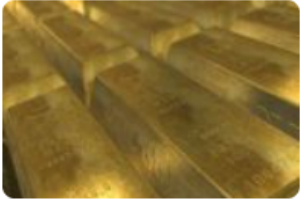
